TECHNO CORNER

Praveen's Microtube Technique (PMT) For Broken File Retrieval from Root Canals.



"A Dentist who has not fractured a file, reamer or a broach has not treated enough Root canals"- Dr. Louis I Grossmann (Father of Endodontics). In today's age of access to information and easy availability of 'second opinions' from other Dentists, removal of a broken file from the Root canal has become a necessity to avoid embarrassment and save the tooth from extraction. As modern Endodontics has progressed, there have been several Instrument Retrieval devices developed such as Masseran's, IRS, Yoshi's Loop, PMT, BTR pen, etc which can grasp and retrieve the fragment loosened prior by ultrasonics very effectively. However, each technique has a critical caveat such as the fragility of loop device (only minimal forces may be applied to pull out the fragment) or the unnecessary dentin sacrifice with micro-trephines of the microtube techniques (Masserans, IRS, Zumax). They are also very expensive to use in regular clinical practice.




Figure 1: (a) The correct Microtube size is determined and inserted into the canal till the head of the file, till the head engulfs and is adapted around the broken fragment. (b) The plunger is then inserted to grip the broken file against the tube and (c) the entire assembly is pulled out with the broken file. (d) Three different sizes of Microtube and Plunger assembly are depicted.




Figure 2: (a&b) Patient c/o pain in lower left teeth where a bridge was done 3 years ago. Tooth number 37 with a fractured file fragment in mesial canal and periapical radiolucency. (c) Access through the crown and GP retrieval done to expose the instrument. (d) After creating space for microtube using ultrasonics, the microtube was fitted around the head of the broken file. (e) Microtube try in IOPAR. (f&g) The plunger was adapted to grip the broken file and the entire assembly was pulled out successfully. (h) Post obturation IOPAR; patients symptoms were resolved. 26

The Praveen's Microtube (PMT) Device (patent pending) is a Microtube plunger based Instrument Retrieval device made in India and Japan. Its unique microtube design allows dentin conservation whilst gripping the broken file tightly for efficient removal (Fig 1). It contains 14 different sizes of Microtube and few universal and assorted plungers which can be used for a range of scenarios such as apical file fragment removals and metal post retrievals (Fig 2). 
UNDERGRADUATE: Mokshaa Tejashwini

The story juxtaposes the lives of the Kamal Hassans brought up in different strata giving you visual treat. Kamal Hassan, the one man who has strived to put Indian cinema on the global platform with his exemplary all round skills in cinema. This film is one of the grounds where his versatility in acting is showcased in terms of his mannerisms, dialect, voice modulation and body language clearly defining each of the Kamal. He carries out each role so convincingly that one starts to believe there actually are four Kamal Hassans in reality!

The storyline has so much depth that the director decided to narrate the prelude of the film in a single title track having faith in Ilayaraja's prowess in music.
