He categorized India into three strata according to population and per capita income.

The 3 Box Balance Strategy manages the present, selectively forgets the past and creates the future. The first box is about optimizing the current system, competition for the present, closing the performance gap and linear innovations. The second and third boxes are about competition for future, closing the possibility gap and non-linear innovation. Customers in emergent markets are different from those in developed or developing countries. Dr. P.V. Vijayaraghanvan, Vice-chancellor, SRIHER felicitated the chief guest, Prof. K.V.Somasundaram, Professor of Eminence & Adviser (Academic), SRIHER, Prof. T.
