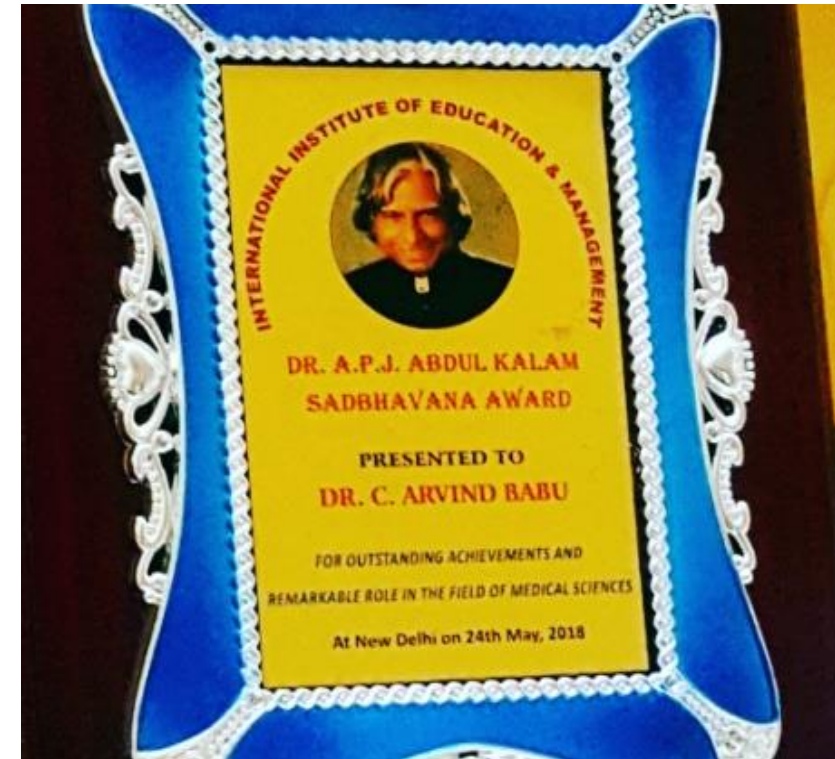

Chennai: She broke the national record earlier this year and now Aarathy Kasthuri Raj, a 24-year-old medical graduate from Chennai, is among the four skaters who will represent India at the Asian Games next month.

Aarathy currently holds the national record in the 300m category and she made her mark in the World Roller Skating championships in Arnhem (Netherlands) last week, finishing 15th in the 10,000 metres point-to-point race. She also finished 14th in the marathon competing with 146 skaters.

Aarathy's father, who is a businessman, and mom (a doctor) inspired her to take up a sport from a young age. After attempting swimming and tennis initially, Aarathy

took to skating at seven and trained in different clubs, finally settling down with Sathya P Skating Acade-

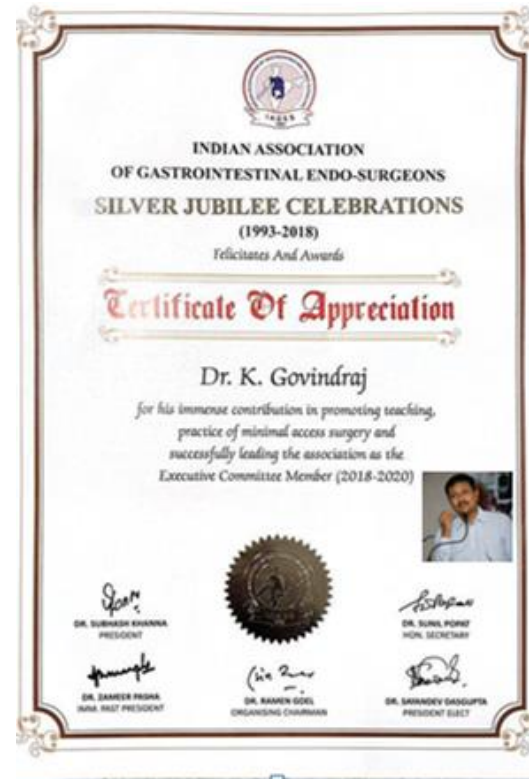
my in Chennai.

Having finished her MBBS degree last year from Ramachandra Medical College, the skater has now taken a break to take part in the Asian Games.

"I definitely want to pursue my PG as well but skating is my passion and at the moment, I want to give my best for the Asian Games and the Asian championship in South Korea after that," said Aarathy, whose preference is long distance races. The skater will also be heading off to the World Roller Games in Barcelona in 2019.

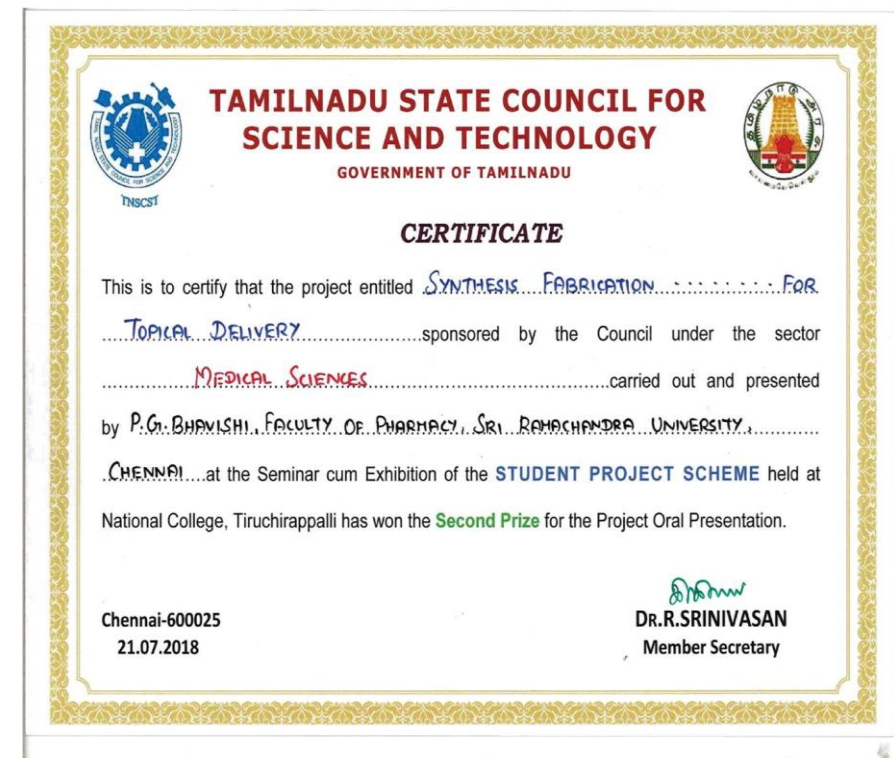

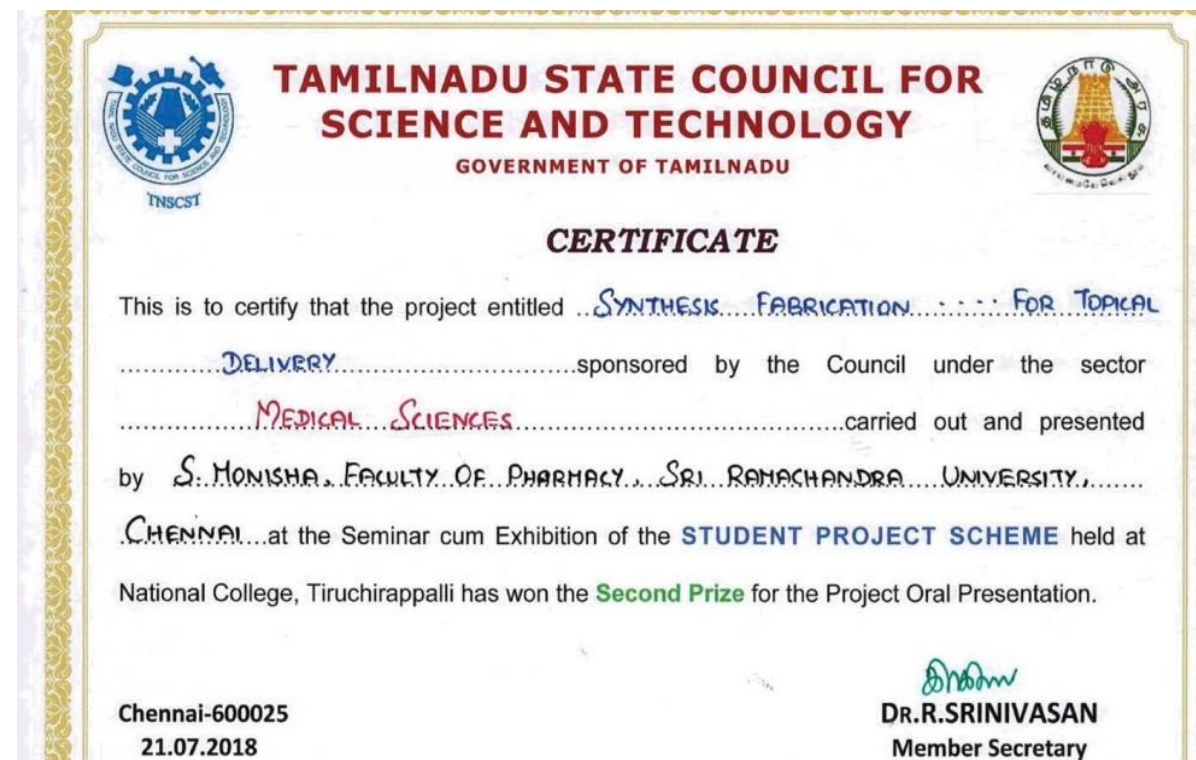
