The institutions had its beginnings in 1985 as a medical college, the Sri Ramachandra Medical College and Research Institute, established as a not-for-profit and self-financing institution, by the Sri Ramachandra Educational and Health Trust under its Founder & Managing Trustee. The Govt. of India declared Sri Ramachandra Medical College and Research Institute as a Deemed to be University in September 1994 under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956. In August 2018, the university was renamed as Sri Ramachandra Institute of Higher Education and Research (SRIHER) as per the MHRD directions.

Shri. V.R. Venkataachalam is currently the Chancellor and Shri R.V. Sengutuvan is the Pro-Chancellor of the Deemed University.

Campus and Facilities

Spread over 150 acres, the Deemed University is housed in a refreshingly green campus. Well-manicured lawns, sprawling open spaces and trees dot the campus. Eligibility

General Eligibility requirements

Admission to postgraduate (PG) programs for NRI / FNs candidates, shall be processed on first-cum-first-served merit basis, subject to:

- Meeting the program-specific eligibility criteria as prescribed by the relevant regulatory or statutory bodies.
- Academic performance in the qualifying undergraduate programs

Candidates under the NRI / FNs categories are exempt from appearing for university entrance examination unless specified. However, the University reserves the right to conduct an online interview, where deemed necessary.

For programs governed by statutory or regulatory councils such as AICTE/INC/RCI etc. allocation of seats under NRI/FNs category shall strictly adhere to the stipulations, norms and regulations prescribed by the respective councils.

The seat allocation for NRI/FNs candidates for other programs under University regulations is determined annually.

Regulatory compliance and right to amend: The eligibility criteria and admission process are subject to change in accordance with guidelines, regulations, or directives issued from time to time by the concerned statutory and regulatory authorities, including but not limited to the Ministry of Education (Government of India), UGC, RCI, NCAHP etc. and/or orders of competent courts.

The responsibility to ensure compliance with eligibility requirements for the program applied for rests solely with the candidate. Admission obtained on the basis of false, incorrect, or suppressed information shall be cancelled without notice, and all fees paid shall be forfeited.

Candidates seeking admissions to postgraduate (PG) programs should have obtained their qualifications from a recognized University.

Candidates with Foreign qualifications must submit equivalency certificate from the UGC equivalence portal <https://equivalence.ugc.ac.in>

Non-Resident Indians - Admission guidelines for Post graduate Programs 2026-27

Non-Resident Indian (NRI) Categories

NRI: Indian citizens who have completed their qualifying undergraduate examination from recognized University outside India and whose parent(s)/brother /sister also hold NRI status.

NRI Sponsored: Students who have completed their qualifying undergraduate examination in India and if the candidate fulfills the conditions prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India [in its order dated 22.08.2017 passed in W.P. (C) No. 689 of 2017].

Who are eligible to be a Sponsored?

- If the mother or father of the candidate is a NRI and residing abroad ordinarily; or
- If the first degree relation (brother and sister) of the candidate is a NRI and residing abroad ordinarily or

- If any of the 'nearest relation' is a NRI and residing abroad ordinarily. Nearest relation would include: paternal uncle or aunt / maternal uncle or aunt /paternal grandparents / maternal grandparents /first degree maternal or paternal first cousins

Application & Admissions Process

Application process overview

- Last date for receipt of filled in applications **10/07/2026**.
- Application must be submitted only under the NRI category and they are exempt from appearing for university PG entrance examination for programs governed under university regulations unless otherwise specified. However, the University reserves the right to conduct an online interview, where deemed necessary.
- Applications under NRI category are fast tracked and processed through the International Relations Office (IRO) and the Admissions Cell of the Deemed University.
- All admissions are provisional, subject to the candidate's fulfilment of all prescribed eligibility conditions, and obtaining appropriate student visa if needed.

Admission Steps

STEP 1 — Submission of Application

STEP 2 — Application Scrutiny

The Admissions Committee and International Relations Office review the application to verify eligibility and documentation.

STEP 3 — Offer of Provisional Admission

Eligible candidates receive an Offer of Provisional Admission for the selected program.

STEP 4 — Payment of Prescribed Fees

Pay tuition and other applicable fees within the deadline specified in the Offer of Provisional Admission.

STEP 5 — Confirmation of Provisional Admission

Upon successful fee payment and submission of under graduate program, the University will issue a letter of Confirmation of Provisional Admission.

STEP 6 — Document Verification & Admission Formalities

Report to the University on the specified date for physical verification of original documents and completion of admission procedures.

Note

- Candidates should send only photocopy of undergraduate transcripts and other credentials only. (Please do not send original certificates at this stage). All original certificates will be verified and accepted only at the time of admission.
- If any candidate is currently enrolled in the undergraduate program, the transcripts should include all the courses taken as of the date of sending the application. The candidate should send by email copy of the results of the Final UG examinations as soon as they are available. The final original transcripts and the UG degree certificate have to be submitted at this Deemed University on the day of admission.
- Those students who receive the letter of provisional admission will be required to send the first installment payment on or before the date stipulated in the said letter of provisional admission failing which their offer of provisional admission will stand cancelled and the seat would be offered to other applicants.
- Mere receipt of the provisional admission letter shall not entitle admission to a candidate unless he/she completes or has successfully completed the undergraduate degree program from a recognised University and submits documentary proof in original at the time of admission for verification.

Immigration & Statutory Compliances

Visa/ Immigration / FRRO requirements

The International candidates are required to comply with all immigration norms specified by the authorities of the Government of India in regard to admission in educational institutions and stay in India. Failure to do so may attract penalties.

- **Form II (Formerly Form S):** The University will register each student within 24 hours of admission completion all foreign nationals (Including students with OCI card and Citizenship card) with FRRO
- **Form III (Formerly Form C):** Mandatory registration of the residence of the students staying on campus by the university with the FRRO within 24 hours of completion of admission formalities
- Students who reside off-campus should obtain the documents from the landlord or accommodation provider Residential registration details for off-campus students off-campus students must be provided to University.
- **FSIS/FRRO Student Registration:** International students holding Student visa of more than 180 days are required to register themselves with the local Foreigners Regional Registration Officer (FRRO) within 14 days of arrival. They are advised to visit www.indianfrro.gov.in to know the latest updates. During their study period also, they are advised to visit the website frequently.

Fees

Tuition Fees (Total Program Fees)

- i. The tuition fee is as prescribed for the respective programs and is payable in two instalments as included in Offer of Provisional Admission Letter.
- ii. The first instalment must be paid upon receipt of Offer of Provisional Admission Letter, and the subsequent instalment are payable in May of the succeeding years.
- iii. Payment must be made through electronic transfer as per the details provided in the Offer of Provisional Admission Letter.
- iv. Remittance of fees by candidates is subject to applicable statutory regulations governing foreign exchange, including the guidelines of the Reserve Bank of India.

Registration Fee

The registration fee is USD 50, payable one time at the time of admission may be paid along with tuition fees

University Examination Fee

The University examination fee is as prescribed by the University and is payable as notified, typically at the time of examination notification, according to the schedule announced by the University

Health Insurance

Health insurance is charged at USD 50 per year, payable annually

Hostel Fees (including Caution Deposit)

Hostel fees are as applicable depending on room type and are payable at the time of admission and annually thereafter. Room allocation is subject to availability. Applicable caution deposit is included as per hostel category.

University policies and regulations

Anti-ragging Measures

Ragging is strictly prohibited in this campus. Sri Ramachandra Institute of Higher Education and Research (Deemed to be University) strictly enforces anti-ragging measures and the campus is free from any form of ragging. Any violation will be dealt with according to law in force and as per the directives of the Honorable Supreme Court of India.

The Deemed University has adopted the

- "UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009" (as amended);
- "Medical Council of India (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Medical College/ Institutions) Regulations, 2009" (as amended);
- "Dental Council of India Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009" (as amended); and
- All India Council for Technical Education (prevention and prohibition of ragging in Technical Institutions, Universities including Deemed Universities imparting technical education) Regulations 2009.

These Regulations shall be applicable to all students. Full text of the Regulations is available in the University Website: www.sriramachandra.edu

Further, attention of the students and parents is invited to Sections 4 and 5 of the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1997 which are reproduced below:

Section 4: - Whoever commits, participates in, abets or propagates "ragging" within or without any educational institution, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand).

Section 5: - Any student convicted of an offence under Section 4 shall also be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution.

Commencement of classes

Classes for the first year of study would usually commence around 3rd week of July, 2026. Intimation will be sent to all students informing the exact date of commencement well in advance through email to enable them to plan their travel.

On arrival at the University, all students will first report to the Dean of Students who will help the new students to familiarize with all formalities and also to assign hostel accommodation. There will be a short orientation program to help the students to get to know the faculty, staff and the academic administration system.

Medical fitness and immunization

All new students will have to show evidence that he/she has received all the immunizations as necessary. An authorized medical officer at SRMC & RI will conduct a basic health check on all students and those who are found medically fit will only be eligible for admission.

The students shall be required to comply with the requirements prescribed by the respective statutory professional Councils in India, in relation to the programs to which they are admitted.

Change of Name & Date of birth

The Name & Date of birth of the students entered in the school records and submitted to the Deemed University at the time of admission, shall be taken as final proof and no subsequent request for change of name & date of birth will be entertained by the Deemed University, under any circumstance, either during the course of study or after the completion of such study. Every student shall give an undertaking to this effect duly countersigned by his/her parent or guardian, at the time of admission.

Consequence of non-payment of Tuition and other fees as per schedule

In the event of non-payment of tuition fee and other specified fees even after the lapse of the period specified for payment of the fees with penalty, notwithstanding the stage at which the student may be pursuing his program of study, the name of the student concerned will be struck off / removed from the Attendance Register. On such removal of name, the student(s) concerned will not be permitted to the privileges of the program to which he/she has been admitted to, including attending classes/ practical, to enter library and or any other facility provided in the college/Deemed University campus or to obtain any usual certificate such as to avail concession, etc.

In the event of removal of the name of a student from the Attendance Register, re-admission fee, as prescribed by the Deemed University, will have to be paid by the student concerned when he/she is permitted by the authority concerned to make payment of all the unpaid fees due to the Deemed University (i.e., tuition fee and other fee along with the specified penalty).

Similarly, examination fee, as prescribed and notified from time to time, shall be paid on or before the due date. Any delay in payment will attract penalty as specified. If any student fails to remit the examination fee even after lapse of the period specified for payment with penalty, such student will not be issued Hall Ticket for the University examination(s) and debarred from appearing for the University examination(s).

Rules on discontinuance from the program of study

Where any student applies for discontinuance, or without any application discontinues on his/her own, from the program to which he/she has been admitted to, for any reason, either after the cut-off date prescribed by the statutory authorities for admission to the first year of the program concerned or where the seat is rendered vacant without having any chance of being filled up with any other candidate, such students will have to remit the tuition fee and other applicable fees for the 'Entire/remaining program period'. Unless and until payment of all the prescribed fee for the entire/remaining program period is made to the Deemed University account, such student shall not be entitled to any certificate including transfer certificate, mark sheets etc., to be issued by the Deemed University and to get back his/her original

certificates deposited with the Deemed University at the time of admission.

All students and parents will be required to furnish a declaration agreeing to the above said conditions at the time of admission.

Student Support Services

The International Relations Office provides services such as completion of statutory requirements, like issue of Bonafide Certificates, assistance in obtaining APAAR ID for students who don't have AADHAR cards, completion of exit requirements, and other matters
